Wyvern 10K Parking Information

There is limited car parking for the race and so we would like to encourage as many of you as possible to get to the event by:

- Walking
- Cycling (we have loads of space in our bike shelters which you'll find to the right of the school buildings)
- Public Transport (<https://www.eastleigh.gov.uk/parking,-travel-roads/public-transport.aspx>)
- Car Sharing
- Using our drop off zone (which will operate from the front of the school buildings).

Designated Parking

We do have some designated parking.

- If the weather has been wet, prior to the event, some of the grass parking areas may have to be taken out of operation.
- Map 1 (Page 2) shows the car park areas. We will signpost these with yellow signs with a black Wyvern.
- Our stewards will close each park as it becomes full and direct cars to the next available.
- When parking, please make sure that you do not block in any other vehicles or park across accesses.

On Road Parking

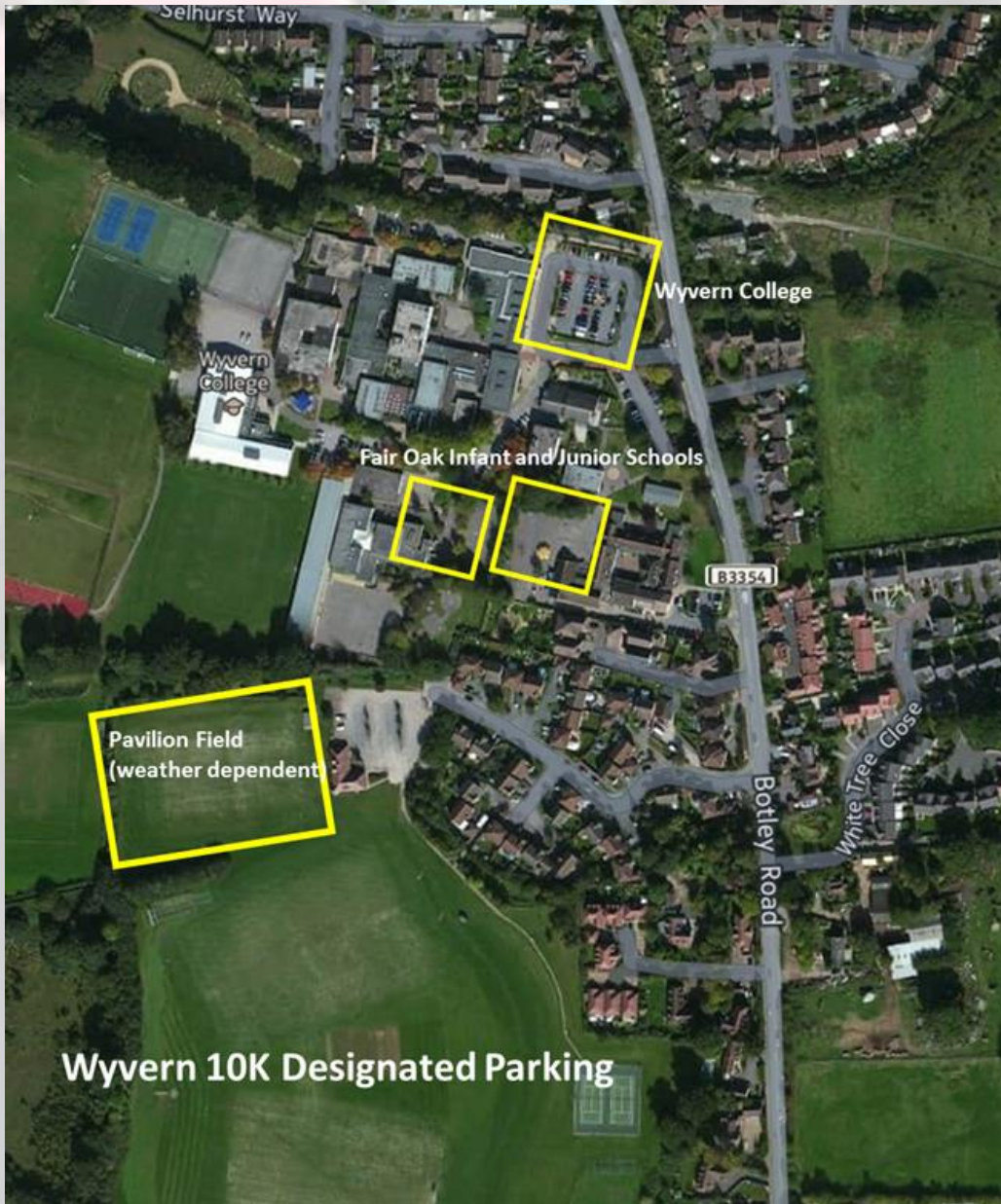
There is on road parking throughout Fair Oak but **please**:

- Do not park in the areas in red on Map 2 (page 3) which are directly on the route of the 10K and subject to closures.
- Do not park over the entrance to resident's drives
- Do observe parking restrictions like single and double yellow lines
- Do not park in such a way that prevents easy passage for vehicles along that road.
- Make sure you know how to get to and back from the college!
